
Public Disclosure of disposition of Anti-Doping Matter in accordance with Rule 14.3.2 – Adaejah Hodge (BVI)

1. On 28 August 2024 and 30 August 2024, Adaejah Hodge¹ (“the **Athlete**”) provided Samples In Competition at the World Athletics U20 Championships in Lima, in the context of Testing conducted by the Athletics Integrity Unit (“**AIU**”) of World Athletics which resulted in Adverse Analytical Findings for GW501516 sulfone and GW501516 sulfoxide, which are Metabolites of GW501516 (“the **AAF**”), a Non-Specified substance, prohibited at all times².
2. On 22 November 2024, the AIU notified the Athlete of the AAF in person in Georgia, USA including of potential Anti-Doping Rule Violations (“**ADRVs**”) pursuant to Rule 2.1 and Rule 2.2 of the 2024 World Athletics Anti-Doping Rules (“**ADR**”) and an immediate Provisional Suspension. The Athlete immediately attended an interview with AIU representatives and provided an explanation for the AAF.
3. Following interview, the Athlete submitted additional information to the AIU relating to her explanation for the AAF including attending a further interview with AIU representatives on 17 January 2025.
4. The AIU, the Athlete and WADA (“the **Parties**”) subsequently entered into a Case Resolution Agreement in accordance with Rule 10.8.2 ADR pursuant to which:
 - 4.1. the Athlete acknowledges that she committed ADRVs under Rule 2.1 and Rule 2.2 ADR;
 - 4.2. the Parties agree that the Athlete’s explanation establishes (on the balance of probabilities) that she ingested GW501516 unknowingly;
 - 4.3. the Parties agree that the Athlete’s ADRVs were not intentional;
 - 4.4. the Athlete agrees to be sanctioned for the ADRVs with a period of Ineligibility of two (2) years pursuant to Rule 10.2.2 ADR;
 - 4.5. the Parties agree that, in accordance with Rule 10.8.2 ADR, the period of Ineligibility shall commence on the date of Sample collection (i.e., 28 August 2024) and continue until and including **27 August 2026**;
 - 4.6. the Parties agree that a period of **7 months** of the otherwise applicable period of Ineligibility in the Athlete’s case shall be suspended for Substantial Assistance in accordance with Rule 10.7.1 ADR. The Athlete therefore became eligible from and including **28 January 2026**;

- 4.7. in accordance with Rules 9 and 10.10 ADR, all competitive results of the Athlete from 28 August 2024 to 22 November 2024 are disqualified with all resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
5. Following the Case Resolution Agreement, there is no right of appeal in the matter under the ADR.
6. The disposition of the Athlete's case is now therefore published in accordance with Rule 14.3.2 of the ADR.
