
Public Disclosure of disposition of Anti-Doping Matter in accordance with Rule 14.3.2 – Gudaf Tsegay (ETH)

1. On 5 December 2025, Gudaf Tsegay¹ (the “**Athlete**”) provided a urine Sample Out-of-Competition during a Doping Control conducted under the Testing Authority of World Athletics-Athletics Integrity Unit (“**AIU**”), which resulted in an Adverse Analytical Finding for a Metabolite of Letrozole (the “**AAF**”), a Specified Substance, prohibited at all times².
2. On 26 January 2026, the AIU notified the Athlete of the AAF and of potential Anti-Doping Rule Violations (“**ADRVs**”) pursuant to Rule 2.1 and Rule 2.2 of the World Athletics Anti-Doping Rules (“**ADR**”).
3. On 27 January 2026, the Athlete responded to the notice from the AIU with an explanation for the AAF and thereafter submitted supporting medical documents and evidence.
4. The AIU, the Athlete and WADA (the “**Parties**”) subsequently entered into a Case Resolution Agreement in accordance with Rule 10.8.2 ADR pursuant to which:
 - 4.1. the Athlete acknowledges that she committed ADRVs under Rule 2.1 and Rule 2.2 ADR;
 - 4.2. the Athlete agrees to be sanctioned for the ADRVs with a **period of Ineligibility of four (4) months** pursuant to Rule 10.6.1(a) ADR;
 - 4.3. the Parties agree that the period of Ineligibility shall commence on the date on which the Athlete accepted the Case Resolution Agreement, *i.e.*, 1 June 2026. Therefore, the period of Ineligibility shall be in effect until, and including, **30 September 2026**; and
 - 4.4. in accordance with Rule 10.10 ADR, the Athlete’s competitive results from 5 December 2025 are Disqualified with all resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prize money/prizes.
5. Following the Case Resolution Agreement, there is no right of appeal in the matter under the ADR, the disposition of the Athlete’s case is published in accordance with Rule 14.3.2 ADR.
