

AIU REACHES OUT

Follow the AIU's Outreach Programme at the IAAF World Championships London 2017

To mark the IAAF World Championships London 2017, the Athletics Integrity Unit (AIU) is running a joint Education and Prevention Outreach campaign under the Clean Athletics programme of the host federation.

From 30 July – 13 August, the AIU and UK Athletics is running a unique education programme for competing athletes and support personnel at team hotels and competition venues to help foster a greater awareness and understanding of the AIU and its mission to create a level playing field for the sport of athletics.

To create greater awareness amongst the athlete community of the need to speak out against doping and other forms of misconduct, the AIU, in collaboration with the IAAF Athletes' Commission, has created an Athletes' Pledge in multiple languages that will be signed by competitors at a handful of locations. The WADA Athlete Committee will also be lending support to the campaign by signing the pledge in London. The IAAF Athletes Commission and the AIU will also organise seminars and open sessions for athletes and support personnel, with anti-doping and integrity matters to be two of the focus topics.
