1 SEPTEMBER 2022, MONACO: Information posted recently on the Athletics Integrity Unit's website and its Twitter account erroneously stated that Mark Otieno Odhiambo was charged with Tampering.

The AIU apologises for this error and confirms that Mr Odhiambo's case only concerns the Presence/Use of a Prohibited Substance. That case is currently before the Disciplinary Tribunal and no further comment will be made whilst the matter is pending.
